## Sky Blues in the Community

Letter to players for shadow squad trial



Dear Parent,

My name is Shaun Pierce and I am Assistant Community Manager for Sky Blues in the Community. Mark Fogarty (Head of recruitment for CCFC Academy) and I have had a number of meetings and have set up a shadow squad to run closely with the academy next season.

The shadow squad is going to be 15 players for each age group who will be working on the same sessions as the academy team. It will be coached jointly from our Level 3 community coaches and the academy staff. It will be on a Tuesday night from 6.00pm – 7.30pm at the Alan Higgs centre, Coventry for under 7's up to under 12's. Under 13's will train on a Friday night at Aylesford School in Warwick from 5.00 – 6.30. There will also be training days and matches during the school holidays. While they are in the shadow squad there is nothing to stop them playing and training with any junior football club, all the coaching and games is on top of what they are all ready learning. If they do progress onto the full academy team then they do ask them to stop playing for their local club teams.

We have joined a league format with 12 other professional football clubs who we will play games against every school holiday. As part of the shadow team all players will receive their own CCFC training kit with initials on it. The cost for the Shadow Squad will be an initial £80.00 start up fee which will include the kit and £20.00 a month direct debit thereafter. This is to cover all our costs and not to make any money.

We are holding **Open Trial Dates** which we would like you to attend for the remaining places in our squads.

**Under 7, 8 & 9's (class year 2, 3 & 4) on Wednesday the 22<sup>nd</sup> September at AT7 Sports centre, Coventry • between 5.30 – 7.00.**

**Under 12 & 13's (class year 7 & 8) on Friday the 24<sup>th</sup> September at Aylesford School, Warwick from 5.00 – 6.30.** (The under 10 & 11's are very close to being full so we are not holding open trials for these age groups at this time but we will be selecting players from our development centres who show potential to fill the final places.) If successful at the trial you will be offered a place to join the shadow squad for this season if not you will offered a place in one of our development centres to keep improving your football skills with a view to moving up at a later date. I hope you agree this is a great opportunity.
