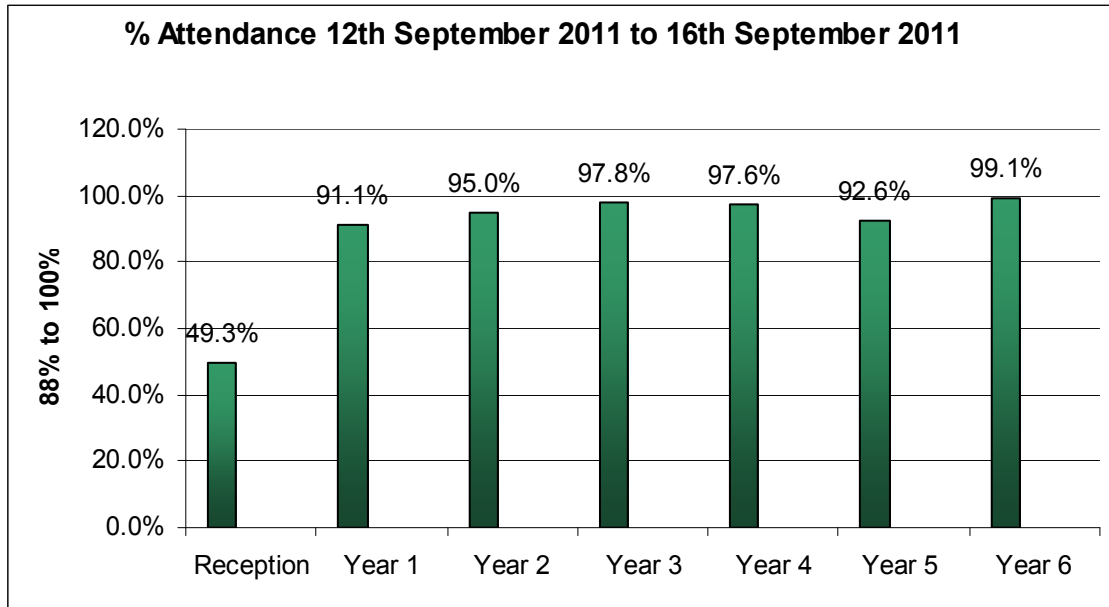
### Annual Consent Forms
