Monday 13th December which is your last lesson

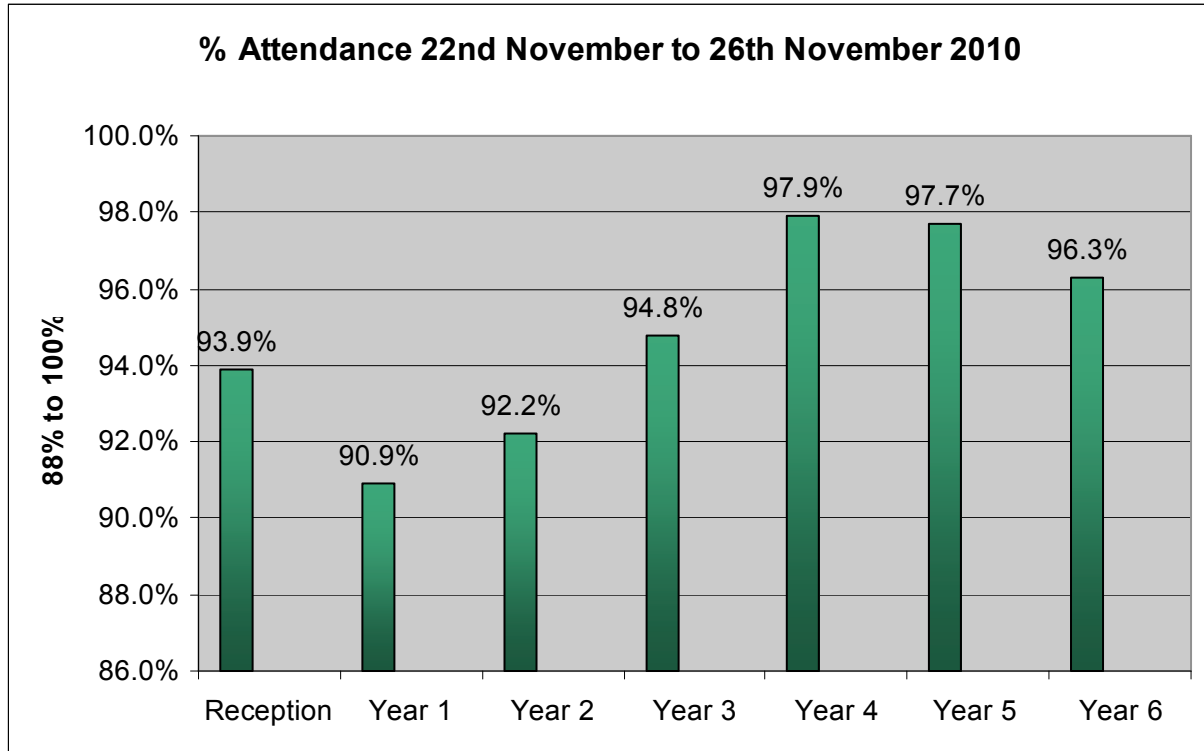


Morrison Vouchers
