Dinner Money Reminder



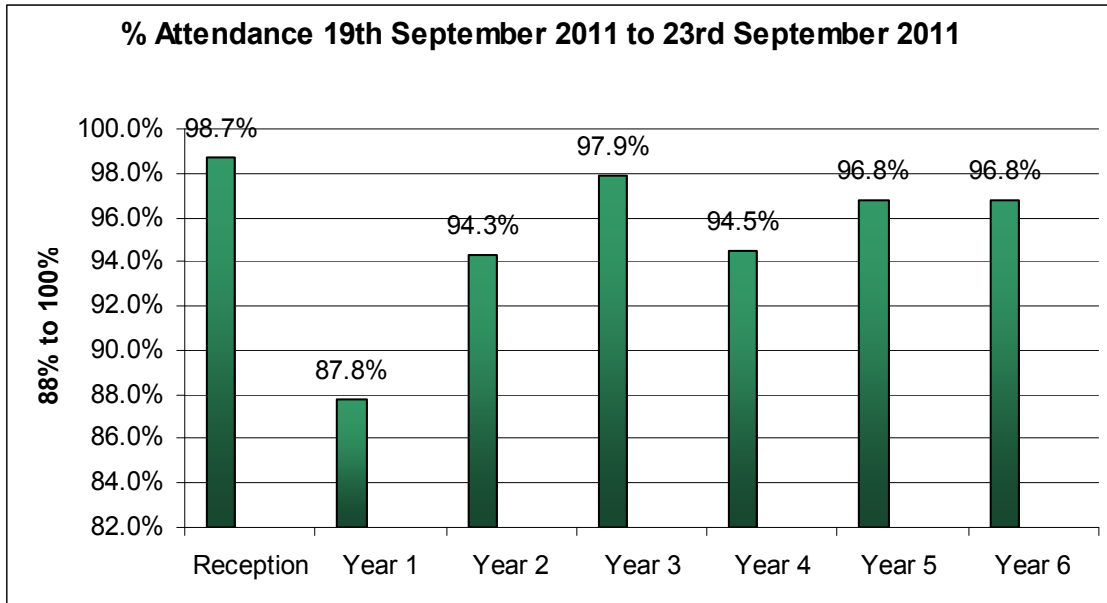
If your child has school dinners please ensure that dinner money is in school on **MONDAY** in a sealed and named envelope and that if possible the correct money is enclosed.
