Years 3,4,5 & 6



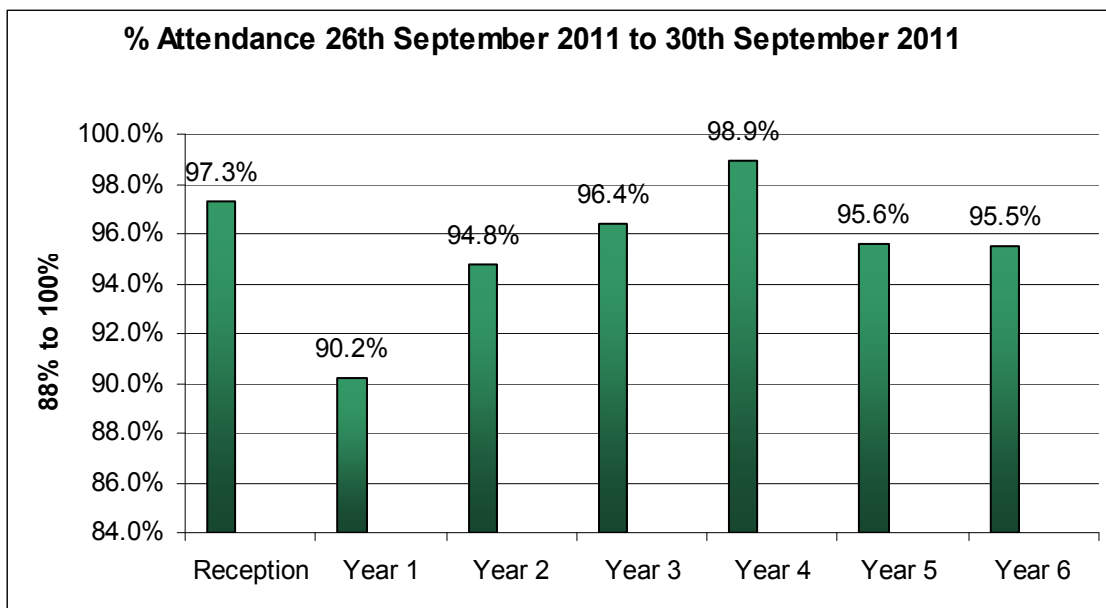
